

January & February MSC Kayak Group Outing

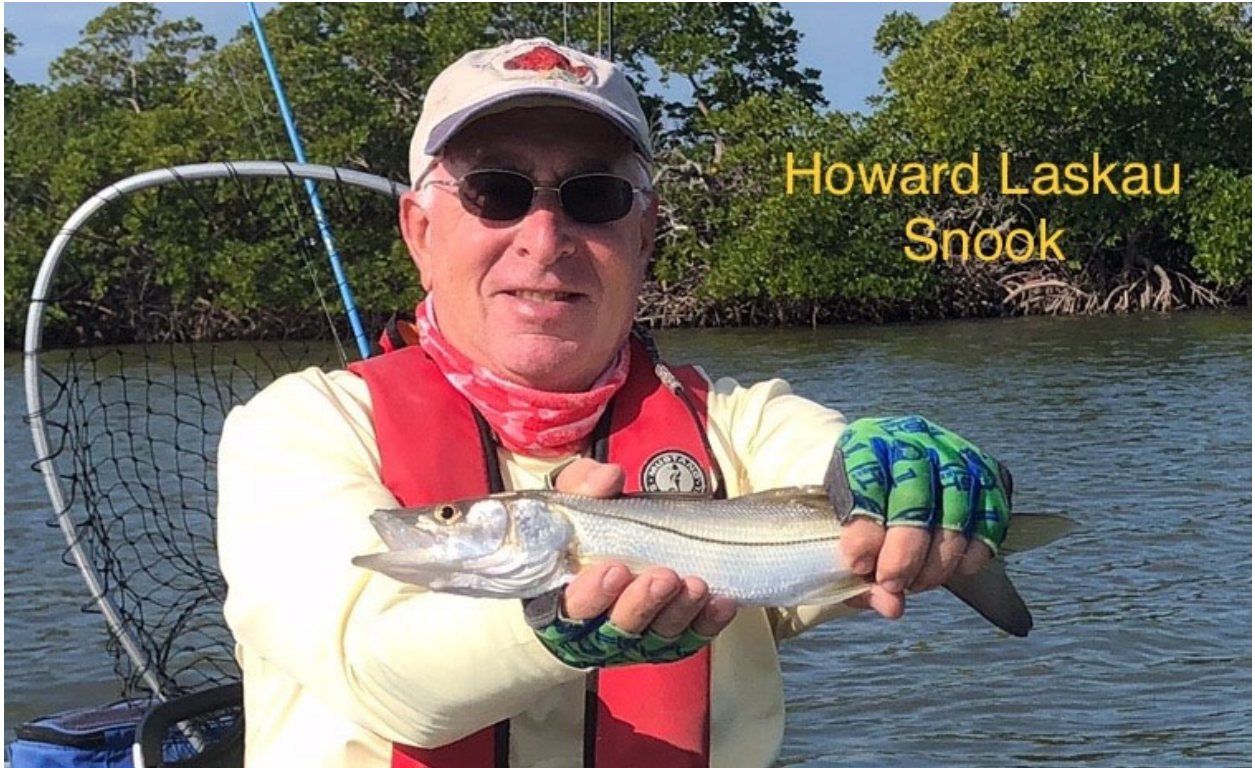
Hell's Gate & Everglades City
