### **President's Message for November 2022**



Welcome November!

October was like a Steven King novel. Hurricane lan's impact was varied and insidious. Unlike the pounding we received with Irma, the wholesale structural damage was minimal. Most roofs, lanai birdcages, and trees survived. Not many blue tarped roofs or huge piles of rotting vegetation were seen on island. Rather our members suffered vehicle, dock and lift damage. We also had many boats damaged and a high number of

flooded ground floor or low elevation dwellings.

This time it was the wind driven storm surge, born from a slow-moving storm, which creeped higher and higher until the water found its way into garages and pools. What we did see were huge piles of waterlogged furnishing, brown lawns and shrubs, and the "car graveyard" on Bald Eagle.

In addition, once the water receded and the skies cleared, we found our island without power, cell phone, and internet service. For some this was a temporary 2- or 3-day problem, for others the power and cell service were restored faster than the internet and cable TV. Some members were without reliable internet for more than two weeks. While this inconvenience pales in comparison to the near total destruction in those locations where lan made landfall, it truly complicated life for those now stuck in a "pre-digital" world. Think of the 80's but without big-hair or disco music.

For our club, it became almost impossible to communicate effectively with the members. You could not depend on all those digital tools we use to keep our members informed.

The board met, post lan, to review the upcoming October fishing events and concluded that the loss of boats, lifts, marinas, and the hazardous conditions in the waterways, made holding our two premier events untenable. We postponed them until November. Members are still working to get their lifts and dock power restored and/or dealing with home repairs and the need to replace, rebuild or repower their boats.

One fishing event that was not cancelled is the Triple Crown. Anglers in that four month-long event sought to improve their standings and several big fish were caught, including some tarpon. Who will win the event this year – stay tuned. The reporting of the event standings paused on 10/18 just to keep it interesting.

With the worst of October behind us we can look forward to November and be thankful for dodging a much worse drubbing from Ian.

## Offshore Update - Nov 2022

#### What's Happening Offshore...

ARS (American Red Snapper) - If you missed the summer season, or want to catch more ARS (...and own a gas station), there are 2 fall season weekends left – Nov 11-13 and 25-27. Go get em!

Red Grouper is closed to recreational anglers and for hire vessels through Dec 31, 2022 in state and federal waters. I do not recommend catch and release for these fish during the closed season due to the potentially high barotrauma mortality rate, let them be and they will be plentiful when the season re-opens.

Prior to the hurricane, there had been some nice snapper being caught, including some nice Muttons, with many in shallower water (50-90') near reefs / wrecks. I snapper fished once since the hurricane and it was a bust, hopefully it was just a bad day, but we did not mark the normal schools of snapper on the wrecks we fished, perhaps they were still scattered. There were a lot of Tripletail hanging around a floating palm tree in 70' of water, all undersized unfortunately – keep an eye on the crabs traps nearshore and out for Tripletail laying under the buoys, they cannot resist a live shrimp freelined or under a small float. Cobia are in the area migrating south and have been seen / caught on several of the nearshore reefs / wrecks, keep a live bait or big jig handy in case one pulls up behind your boat. African Pompano can be found typically near structure and as shallow as 80'. AJ's are around structure as well and season is open again until Nov 1. Spanish Mackerel schools are showing up feeding on the bait schools, look for surface activity and working birds to locate them, they are lots of fun on light tackle – don't forget the wire leader! Trolling lures or drifting larger live baits on the outer edges of the Spanish Mackerel schools may find a hungry King too. Permit are still here for another month or so, try the wrecks and reefs with higher relief and towers, they usually cannot resist a live crab.

Pick a calm day and get out there and have some fun...and be safe.

- Total combined length of 3 legal Snapper (Yellowtail or Mangrove) Prizes for top three boats and largest legal Snapper
- Wild Card Fish is Barracuda Prize for largest fish and most fish caught (NOTE: there is a size and bag limit in state waters, there is no size or bag limit in Federal waters 9 miles and out). If entering for largest fish, please measure per rule 7 below. If entering for most fish, a photograph of each legal fish individually is sufficient. Be careful handling these fish, their teeth are dangerous.

<u>Captains Meeting</u>: Friday Dec 2 4:00 pm at Crazy Flamingo. If you wish to register in advance, please email signup sheet to Jim Scarpa at the address above and make arrangements with Jim to drop off the entry fee or have it picked up prior to the event.

### **Rules:**

- 1. ALL Captains must be an active MSC Member.
- 2. Captain / Boat may only fish one day, Captain may fish as a crew member with another Captain / Boat.
- 3. MSC "No Guide Rule" applies No fishing with, or on, a guide's boat.
- 4. MSC "Offshore Boundaries" apply South to Lat N 25.10.0, North to Lat N 26.05.5120', must fish within these boundaries and at a depth of 85' or less.
- 5. ALL Captains must declare their fishing day in advance to Jim.
- 6. "Two Line Rule" applies No more than two rods per angler.
- 7. The fish being entered must be photographed individually on a vertical edge tournament ruler, mouth closed and tight against the vertical edge of the ruler (not following the measurement rules may result in a reduction in size if the measurement is not clearly evident). All photos must be emailed to Jim Scarpa at the email address above on the day caught.


